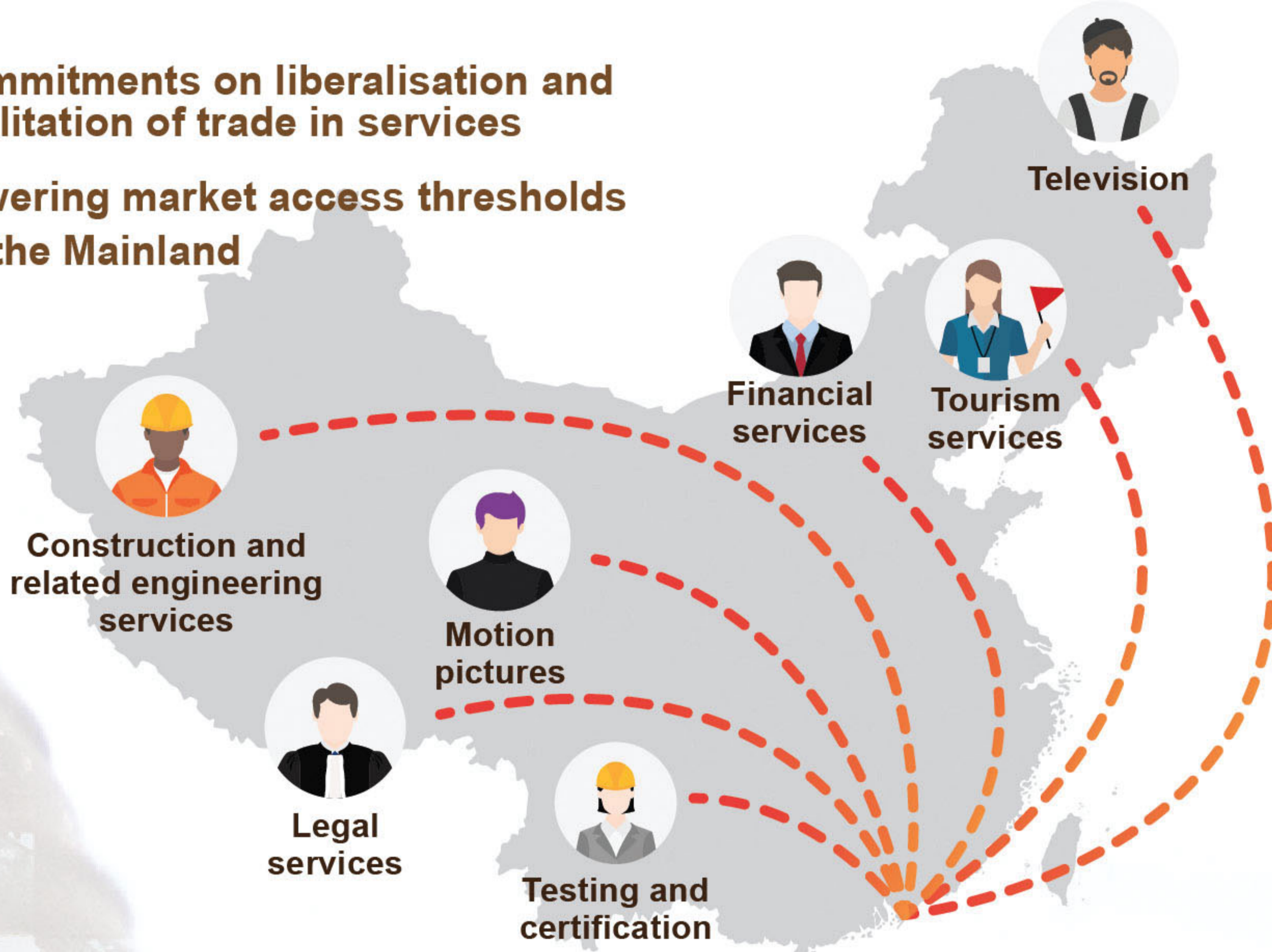
Agreement on Trade in Services

basically achieved liberalisation of trade in services

The “Most-Favoured Treatment” provision under the Agreement on Trade in Services under CEPA specifies that any preferential treatment the Mainland accords to other countries or regions, if more preferential than those under CEPA, will be extended to Hong Kong, **assuring that Hong Kong continues to enjoy the most preferential liberalisation measures of the Mainland.**

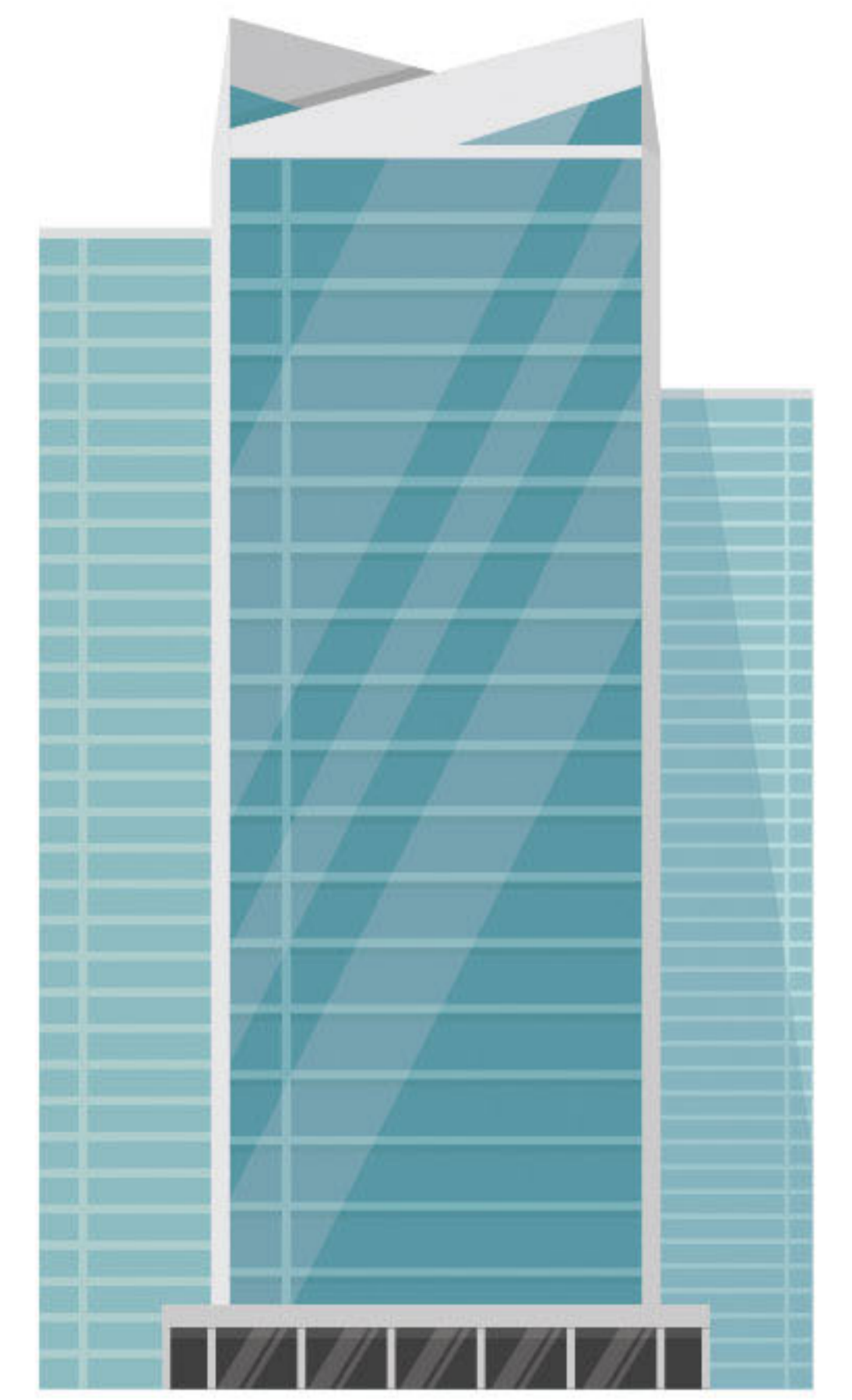


**Introducing new liberalisation measures in service sectors

The Amendment Agreement includes measures for pilot implementation in the nine municipalities of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA), not only do they satisfy the keen demand from the Mainland for the quality services of Hong Kong, but also facilitate Hong Kong businesses and professional services to grasp the enormous opportunities in the Mainland market.

The Mainland fully or partially opens up to Hong Kong's services industry

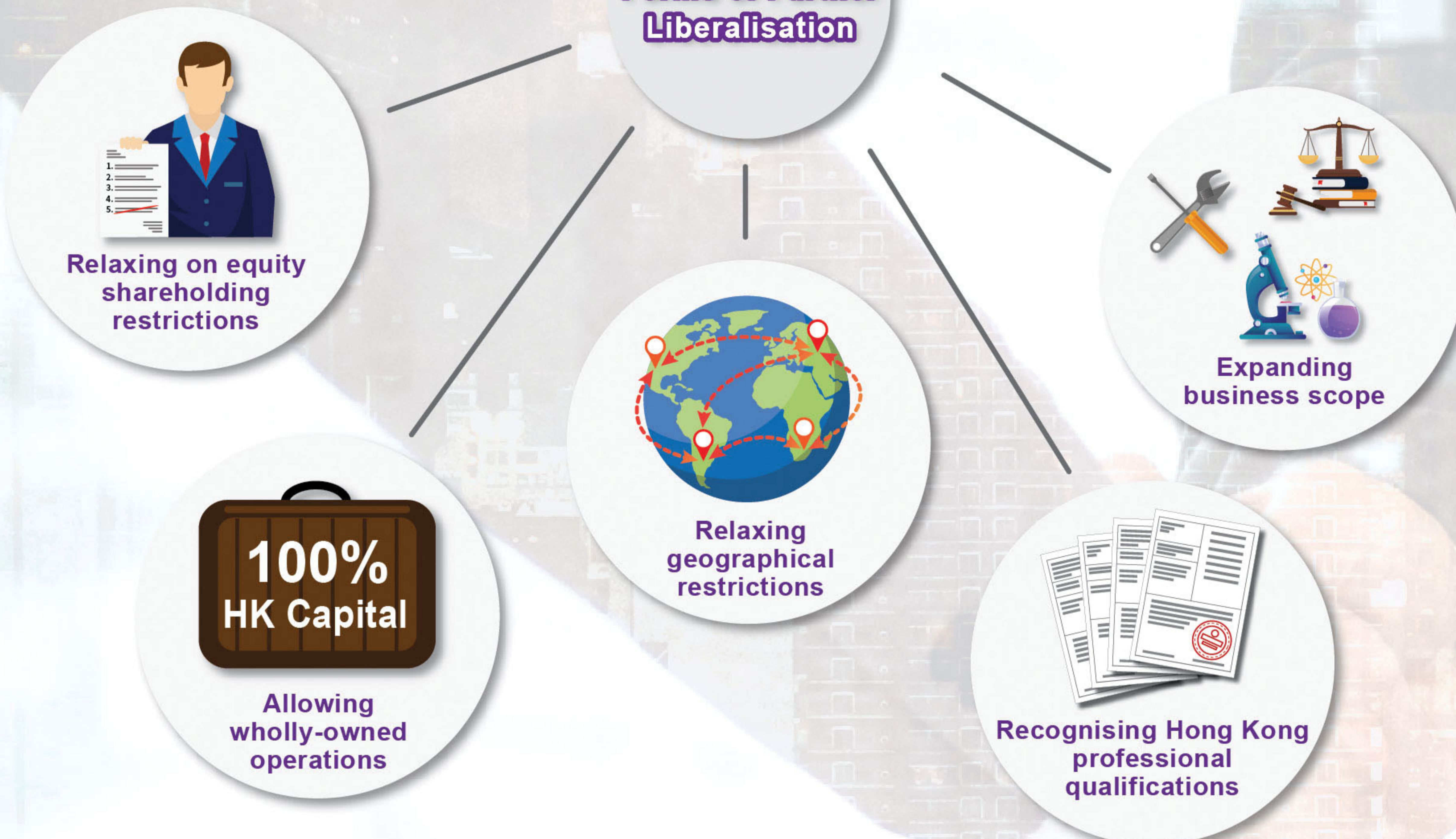

In November 2019, the two sides signed **the Agreement Concerning Amendment to the CEPA Agreement on Trade in Services (Amendment Agreement)**, lowering the market access thresholds on the Mainland for Hong Kong enterprises and professionals in response to proposals of the Hong Kong community for more participation in the development of the Mainland market.
